SAFE SANCTUARIES

CHURCH RESPONSIBILITIES

Home Church responsibilities include:

- 3-Church Chaperones must have a Completed Medical Release form for each student with them at camp.
- 4-Each church will also need to provide a snack for the "Snack Kitty".
